¹For flax (*Linum usitatissimum*), use a higher rate of 600ml/100kg seed if: a) there is a history of high disease pressures in the field or b) where field conditions favour seed and soil-borne pathogens. If using the 600ml/100kg rate, it is highly recommended that the seed be treated into a bin or truck box to allow the treated seed to dry prior to placing into the seeder hopper. This will prevent clumping and bridging in the seeder.

Submit all Bulk Container orders to BASF retailers by

Dec. 31, 2017.

Note: Totes will be made to order only and will not be available after the December 31st deadline. Additional shuttles may be available on a limited basis.

Bulk Container return policy

BASF supports responsible environmental stewardship in the recycling of our Bulk Containers. All containers remain the property of BASF and should be returned for reuse or disposal.

- All empty containers must be returned to the BASF retailer where the purchase was made by September 30, 2017.
- A per container deposit is required at time of invoicing for all products listed, excluding Insure Cereal. Tote deposit \$500/unit. Shuttle or Drum deposit \$300/unit.
- No deposit will be credited for containers that: (i) are returned after September 30; (ii) are damaged; and/or (iii) contain residual product.
- BASF will safely dispose of all unusable containers.
